Slinger / Banksman

Agree and use the signal code with lifting equipment operator and others who are involved in the operation.
Sling various loads using a variety of methods and lifting accessories
Set down various loads at pre-determined positions
Carry out checks on all lifting accessories used
Complete report sheet on any defects found
Return to storage all equipment and accessories used
